

## Remarks:

- 1. Scope 1 Emissions (tonne CO<sub>2</sub>e) is the GHG emissions from sources that are owned or controlled by the port.
- 2. Scope 2 Emissions (tonne CO<sub>2</sub>e) is the GHG emissions from the generation of purchased electricity, steam, heat and cooling.
- 3. Carbon Intensity (kg CO<sub>2</sub>e/TEU), is the total of Scope 1 and Scope 2 GHG Emissions divided by the port's annual throughput.
- 4. The emission factors applied for the calculation of Scope 1 are adopted from the <u>U.S. Environmental Protection Agency</u> and <u>Department for</u> Environment, Food, and Rural Affairs (UK).
- 5. The emission factors applied for the calculation of Scope 2 GHG Emissions are adopted from the International Energy Agency.
